GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

The show and clinic is run in accordance with current SHB(GB) Rules which can be found on the downloads section of <http://www.sporhorsegb.co.uk> and with guidance from The Showing Council Blueprint, in line with Government Restrictions.

SAFETY / INSURANCE

The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards. Competitors are advised to have their own insurance in place. The Committee does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property at the show. Please respect the lovely venue and keep it litter free, pick up after your dog and have it on a lead.

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times. Do not bring un-well horses to the show.

Equine Influenza - Following the advice of The British Equestrian Federation (BEF),

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 – 92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the *primary course* and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

This venue requires that Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show.

Foals:- In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

OBJECTIONS

Objections of any kind must be made in writing, and delivered to the Secretary, within one hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, which deposit will be forfeited if the objection should prove to be frivolous. The Objector must also state the particular and precise character of his objection. All objections will be referred to the Council Committee, whose decision will be final.

PRIZES Cash prizes will be awarded on the day where numbers permit and in line with governing guidelines .

BROOD MARE PREMIUMS

Brood Mare Premiums will be awarded in classes 4,4a,9,9a and 14. Premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward. The premium takes the form of a rosette and Service Voucher to the value of £100, awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used in either of the two years following the year of that award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid up member of the SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

CHAMPIONSHIPS All horses eligible for championships must be forward.

ENTRIES

All showing classes are due by closing date of **Monday 3rd May 2021** No 'entries on the day' are accepted. Entry for the clinic is non-returnable and must be paid at the time of entry, but may be transferable by contacting the entry secretary should you not be able to attend. Entry forms must be accompanied by the correct entry fees. In addition there is a rider/handler first aid fee of £3. See entry form for BACS payment details
